How to Get There:

From San Francisco, take Highway 101 north through Cloverdale. Take Highway 128 west, 55 miles to the coast. Take Highway 1 north to the town of Mendocino. At the first stoplight, turn right (east) onto Little Lake Road (County Road 408). Go 5 1/2 miles to the end of the pavement, where you'll see a sign indicating the way to the main gate to the Mendocino Woodlands. Take the dirt road to your right. Go 3 1/2 miles to the Caretaker's House. Pass Camp 1 on your right and continue passed Camp 3 to Camp 2 at the end of the road.

NOTE: *Regrettably, this camp site may present accessibility issues to some persons with physical disabilities. If you have any questions regarding accessibility, please contact the camp deans.*

WHAT TO BRING:

- Directions to camp – don't forget!
- Clothes that layer
- Sleeping bag and Pillow
- Towels and Personal toiletries
- Flashlights (*Labeled*) and Extra batteries
- Battery powered lantern for cabin
- Jackets, knit caps, sweatshirts
- Mosquito repellent/sun screen
- Hiking shoes, water bottles, day packs
- Earplugs for light sleepers
- Favorite Beverages
- Games to share
- Picnic chairs
- Musical instruments, music & songbooks

- Money: Woodlands Fund raiser, art supplies, etc.

DO NOT BRING:

- Unregistered campers
- Persons under 18

In registering for and attending Labor Day Camp, campers agree to abide by camp rules, which include, but are not limited to:

- ***NO alcohol consumption by those under 21***
- ***NO animals or pets, except service animals (with special permission)***
- ***NO candles, lanterns, heaters, etc. with a flame.***
